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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

This is the first installment of a longitudinal dataset consisting of naturalistic interactions involving 47 full-term infants (24 girls and 23 boys) in Edinburgh, UK. Participating families were asked to record 90 minutes' worth of daily interactions with the target infant when they were 9, 15 and 21 months old. The number and length of individual sessions varied.

Informed written consent has been obtained for sharing of anonymized transcripts from all families and of audio recordings from 24 families.

This submission contains 103 transcripts with audio links and 92 without audio, all from the 9-month sessions. We intend to submit transcripts for the 15 and 21 month recordings in the near future.
