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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

This is the second installment of a longitudinal dataset consisting of naturalistic interactions involving 47 full-term infants (24 girls and 23 boys) in Edinburgh, UK. For the project, participating families were asked to record 90 minutes' worth of daily interactions with the target infant when they were 9, 15 and 21 months old. We have previously submitted data from the 9-month sessions to CHILDES. The current submission contains 60 minutes' worth of transcription for each of the 47 families from the 15-month session.

Informed written consent has been obtained for sharing of anonymized transcripts from all 47 families. Of these, 24 families have also agreed to the audio recordings to be released.

This submission for the 15-month sessions contains 90 transcripts with audio links and 69 without audio.
