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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

20 hours of audio and video recordings of 19 French-speaking children during their second year in kindergarten in France (10 sessions between November 2007 and June 2008). The age range is 3;6.9-4;5.2 in the first session and 4;0.23-4;11.16 in the last session. Two children are not monolingual (RIT's L1 is Portuguese and ELI's L1 is Russian). The data are seminaturalistic with child-child and child-investigator interactions. The children were encouraged to narrate their activites in and out of school, 'read' books and play games. The main transcript tier is orthographic; the dependent tiers are %xmor and %err.

2. Restrictions to be placed on the use of the data:

Last names and locations are sometimes audible in the recordings. They are not transcribed and should never be.
